1. Information We Collect

We collect information that identifies you ("Personal Data") and information that does not directly identify you ("Non-Personal Data").

Personal Data

We collect Personal Data only when you affirmatively provide it to us (e.g., via "contact us" forms or email sign-ups). This may include:

- Name, Email address, and Phone Number.
- Mailing Address and Company Information.

Non-Personal and Automated Data

We may automatically collect certain data through your use of the Site, including:

- **IP Addresses & Log Files:** We collect IP addresses, physical locations, and access times to monitor Site usage.

- **Cookies:** Small files placed on your hard drive to help us manage your interaction with the Site, track click-stream data, and improve Site performance.

2. Why We Use Your Information

We process your information based on the following legal grounds:

- **General Functioning:** When necessary to operate the Site or contact you.
 - **Consent:** When you have given voluntary prior consent for specific uses.
 - **Legitimate Interests:** To improve our Site, contact you in compliance with applicable law, or detect and protect against breaches of policy or law.

3. Data Storage and Retention

- **Retention Period:** We retain Personal Data only as long as necessary for its collected purpose. Personal Data will be purged after three years of nonuse.
 - **Storage:** We store data on cloud-based platforms, including names and email addresses.
 - **Location:** Our Site is intended for use within the United States. By providing data, you consent to transfer and processing within the U.S..

4. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell your personal information. We share data only as follows:

- **Service Providers:** We share data with contractors and vendors (e.g., host server infrastructure, payment processors) who are contractually bound to keep data confidential.
 - **Successors in Interest:** In the event of a merger, sale, or reorganization, data may be transferred, subject to the ethical obligations of the legal profession regarding client confidentiality.
 - **Law Enforcement:** We may share data if required by legal process. This does not apply to any information protected by attorney-client privilege.

5. Your Controls and Choices
